

Student rules when using video conferencing:

Be Safe

- Ask an adult's permission before entering a live Zoom Meeting. -Only put your camera on if your parent has said you are allowed. -If you have a question you can raise your hand (virtually or in real life)

Be Respectful

- Keep your microphone on mute unless you are asked by your teacher to speak.

Listen to the ideas and opinions of others in the discussion.
 Only use the chat function if you are having trouble with the
 Zoom Meeting.

- NO SCREEN RECORDING or SCREEN CAPTURES/SHOTS (you do not have the permission of others in the Zoom.
- Do not bring any pets or family members into the

Zoom. Be Responsible

Display your best behaviour, as if you would in the classroom.
Be ready to listen and engage with the Zoom.
Have your background set to 'blur' (see Student Help Guide) - Wear your sports uniform top during the Zoom.

- Do not speak over your teacher or other students. Be patient and wait your turn.
