



Student rules when using video conferencing:

Be Safe

- Ask an adult's permission before entering a live Zoom Meeting.
- Only put your camera on if your parent has said you are allowed.
- If you have a question you can raise your hand (virtually or in real life)

Be Respectful

- Keep your microphone on mute unless you are asked by your teacher to speak.
- Listen to the ideas and opinions of others in the discussion.
- Only use the chat function if you are having trouble with the Zoom Meeting.
- NO SCREEN RECORDING or SCREEN CAPTURES/SHOTS (you do not have the permission of others in the Zoom).
- Do not bring any pets or family members into the

Zoom. Be Responsible

- Display your best behaviour, as if you would in the classroom.
- Be ready to listen and engage with the Zoom.
- Have your background set to 'blur' (see Student Help Guide)
- Wear your sports uniform top during the Zoom.

- Do not speak over your teacher or other students. Be patient and wait your turn.
